1 General

1.1 General Pricing and Indexes

The pricing model is in general based upon an agreed scope of work (to manufacture a specified product portfolio) from indexes on operation cycle times and cost per operation.

The prices will be adjusted in accordance with the price development of the labour and raw material market. Any regulations must be duly documented by the Supplier.

The prices will only be adjusted as and when labour cost, and/or material cost fluctuate with more than +/- 10%.

Prices will be revised every 12 months, and price adjustments must be notified with a least 3 months' notice.

Product Portfolio

The product portfolio is listed in Appendix 2 and may be subject to change from time to time.

1.2 Price per product

Based upon the general prices as indicated in 1.1 general pricing, the product specific prices are being calculated and listed in Appendix 2.

1.3 Productivity and cost reduction

The supplier shall, as stated in the FPAA, be competitive on cost.

The Parties shall in the first year of a product being launched, and supplied by the Supplier, work together to optimize the production set up. Improvements gained in such exercises shall be reflected in Appendix 2 on a continuous basis.

Cost reduction as a consequence of product changes on current products will be treated separately and independently to above mentioned productivity. Such changes/improvements can be initiated by both Parties and savings gained from improvements shall be equally shared between the Parties.

The Parties have agreed upon an intention to reduce the overhead-ratio as and when business with the Supplier increases.

1.4 Productivity and cost reduction

The Supplier is at all times responsible for minimizing scrap of direct material and to optimize utilization of same.

1 Delivery requirements

1.1 Scope of requirements

Requirements to delivery are regulated by forecasting, delivery terms, capacity and flexibility/ response time, but not limited to such.

1.2 Delivery forecast

SBS shall – if requested by the Supplier - provide volume forecasts to the Supplier. The forecasts shall be delivered in a standard format (Excel format, at agreed intervals) and where reasonable possible, a break-down per product will be provided.

The Supplier will from the forwarded forecast manage own min./max. stock holding in order to fulfil an efficient call off pattern from SBS. Phase-in and phase-out of Products will be handled manually between SBS and the Supplier.

The forecasts from SBS are to be understood and interpreted as volume guidance, and do not represent formal call-offs from SBS.

1.3 Delivery terms

1.4 Capacity and flexibility

The Supplier must ensure to have the necessary capacity in place when needed and is aware that capacity requirements do change significantly during the year.

SBS will observe the supplier's indicated manufacturing lead time.

1.5 Ordering of goods

Based upon the qty. requirements, and time of the year (season), SBS shall order goods from the Supplier up to a frequency of weekly. The ordering of goods is regulated by the SBS Supplier Requirement Manual (logistics) (Appendix 6)

1.6 Lead Times

Lead times have been agreed as follows:

- a. Start-up lead time: to be agreed at quotation stage.

1 Definition
